**REQUIRED SUPPLIES**

**All**

- 4-8 disappearing glue sticks
- 2-4 boxes tissue
- 16 No 2 pencils
- 1 ream plain white printer/copy paper
- 1 Backpack -the standard, fit over your back with 2 shoulder straps works best under our cubbies.
- 6 white plastic/vinyl erasers - STAEDTLER Mars Plastic or Pentel Hi-Polymer are preferred
- 3 pocket folders with or without brads
- 1 sturdy cubby bag (bag to keep personal items in - usually zippered canvas/heavy nylon that can also be put in a three ring binder)

**5 year olds**

- 1 bottle of washable glue
- 1 Bring a copy of your favorite book to share and donate to school - write your name inside
- 3 Spiral notebooks College/narrow ruled at least 1 subject - "Neatbooks" are easier to find but are a hassle at school because the pages keep falling out. Do what you can.
- 1 Box colored pencils and/or washable markers
- 1 package (any quantity) of pencil top erasers
- 1 Ream pastel purple copy/printer paper
- 1 MEAD or comparable brand Composition Primary Journal - This journal has primary lined paper and room at the top of the page for an illustration. This is IMPORTANT and is a hard to find item. Check online.

**6 & 7 year olds**

- 1 Pair of Fiskar or comparable brand scissors
- 1 package (any quantity) of pencil top erasers
- 1 Spiral stenographic notebook
- 1 Box colored pencils and/or washable markers
- 3 Spiral notebooks College/narrow ruled at least 1 subject - "Neatbooks" are easier to find but are a hassle at school because the pages keep falling out. Do what you can.
- 1 package construction paper - any color or size
- 1 MEAD or comparable brand composition book narrow or primary ruled
- 1 copy of a book by Paul Goble. Please do not get The Girl Who Loved Wild Horses.

### **8 years old and up**

- 1 Pair of Fiskar or comparable brand scissors
- 1 Spiral stenographic notebook
- 1 Box colored pencils and/or markers
- 3 Spiral notebooks wide ruled at least 1 subject - "Neatbooks" are easier to find but are a hassle at school because the pages keep falling out. Do what you can.
- 1 quad ruled spiral notebook. 4 squares per inch front and back.

- 1 MEAD or comparable brand composition journal wide ruled
